Key idioms:

1. To come up with a winner

Definition: to think up or create a very good idea

2. Blockbuster

Definition: a big success/a huge hit

3. Bells and whistles

Definition: extra product features/exciting features

4. (to) fast track a project

Definition: to make a project a high priority/to speed up the time frame for a project

5. Stocking stuffer

Definition: a small gift given at Christmas time

6. Big win

Definition: a huge success/a successful product

7. (to) make a killing

Definition: to make a lot of money/to get a lot of money

8. (to) keep something under wraps

Definition: to keep something secret/to not let anyone know about something/to hide something from someone

9. Mum's the word

Definition: to keep quiet/to not tell anyone about something/to keep something secret.

10.(to) get wind of

Definition: to find out about something/to hear something by accident

11.(to) rip off

Definition: to steal something/to take something from someone unfairly or illegally

12. Game plan

Definition: an action plan/a plan for a project

13.(to) get something off the ground

Definition: to get started on something/to begin a project
