3 Business Question Techniques:

- 1. What's your take on....(topic)?
- 2. What do you think about.....(topic)?
- 3. What's your opinion regarding....(topic)?

REVIEW: 3 "COUNTER" Phrases

Question: What if **you don't understand** what the speaker is saying?

- 1. If you want your partner to **REPEAT**, say:
- "Excuse me, could you repeat that, please?"
- NG: What? Huh? Eh? Hai?
- 2. If you want your partner to **speak more SLOWLY** say:
- "Excuse me, could you speak a little slower, please?"
- 3. If **you DON'T UNDERSTAND**, say:
- "Excuse me, what doesmean?" Ex. Excuse me, what does "proposal" mean?
