- Question:
- What are TWO good phrases to use **before** you ask a question in business?

Answer:

- <u>2</u> KEY Phrases to use BEFORE you "ask" a question in business situations:
- 1. If I may ask,
- 2. If you don't mind me asking,.....

Examples:

"If I may ask,....."

- 1. If I may ask, what time is the meeting tomorrow?
- 2. If I may ask, when will you be finished?
- **3. If I may ask**, what do you think about our new plan?

"If I may ask,....."

- 1. If you don't mind me asking, how much is the cost?
- 2. If you don't mind me asking, do you think our new product will be successful?
- 3. If you don't mind me asking, can we have a meeting next week?
