“F” Pronunciation Technique

- F Pronunciation Key Technique:
- Brush bottom lip with upper teeth + breath out sound

- "V" Pronunciation Key Technique:
- Brush bottom lip with upper teeth + **lip vibration sound**

REVIEW: “Discuss a current situation” using the “Rule of 3:”

Use: “3 - Step Speaking Technique”

Step 1: (Start)

Let me update you on our current situation.

Step 2:

To begin with, ...(Point #1 + one or two details)

In addition,(Point #2 + one or two details)

Finally,(Point #3 + one or two details)

Step 3: (Ending)

That's our current situation.

• Example Speaking Script:

- **Let me update you on our current situation.**
 - **To begin with**, we are currently making smartphone apps for our new project. So far, we have made three exciting apps. The project is going well.
 - **In addition**, we are trying to finish making our monthly report for FY15. We believe that we will finish by the end of this month. So, we are working hard every day.
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- **Finally**, we plan to visit our China factory on October 10th to check the progress of the factory line. Last week, there was a delay in production. Therefore, we would like to see if we can solve this issue during our business trip on October 10th.
 - **That's our current situation.**

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LEARN: Using "Rule of 3": Discuss a current situation - (ROUND 2)

Today, we are going to use the "Rule of 3" for meetings, discussions, and teleconferences. Take a look at the example below and analyze how to use the "Rule of 3" with when you "discuss your current situation."

"Discuss a current situation" using the "Rule of 3:"

Use: "3 - Step Speaking Technique"

Step 1: (Start) Let me update you on our current situation.

Step 2:

For starters, ...(Point #1 + one or two details)

Furthermore,(Point #2 + one or two details)

Last but not least,(Point #3 + one or two details)

Step 3: (Ending) That's our current situation.

- **Example Speaking Script:**
 - **Let me update you on our current situation.**
 - **For starters**, we are currently working on developing a plan for our new product. So far, things are going well. We expect to have a draft of our plan by the end of this week.
 - **Furthermore**, we are trying to fix two issues. First, we still have many bugs in our software. So, this issue needs to be fixed as soon as possible. And second, we have a lot of hardware issues that need to be fixed by our engineers. As a result, we are asking our engineers to work faster.
 - **Last but not least**, our sales for the first quarter of FY15 increased. Consequently, we are now trying to expand our sales in both North America and Europe.
 - **That's our current situation.**
