- B: I see.
- Sample Conversation #4:
- A: From my experience, the trains in Kanto are very efficient.
- B: Can you tell me why you think the trains in Kanto are very efficient?

- Sample Conversation #1:
- A: The way I see it, this product is better.
- B: If you don't mind, can you tell me why you think this product is better?
- Sample Conversation #2:
- A: My take is our company condition is improving.
- B: If it's okay with you, can you tell me why you think our company's condition is improving?
- Sample Conversation #3:
- A: From my standpoint, we can't finish on time.
- B: If you don't mind, can you tell me why you think we can't finish on time?
- Sample Conversation #4:
- A: From my experience, HEOS will be successful.
- B: If it's okay with you, can you tell me why you think HEOS will be successful?

- Sample Conversation #5
- A: I tend to believe, our sales will increase this year.
- B: If you don't mind, can you tell me why you think our sales will increase this year?

- A: I have an idea for our new project.
- B: If you don't mind, can you tell me more about your idea?
- Sample Conversation #5:
- A: Our engineers made the specifications.
- B: If it's okay with you, can you tell me more about the specifications?
- Sample Conversation #6:
- A: We will be working with our new client.
- B: If you don't mind, can you tell me more about our new client?
