REVIEW: Business ANSWERING Phrases

- 1. "That's a good question.
- 2. "That's a tough question.
- 3. "That's an interesting question.

REVIEW: Speaking Technique

→ Business Answer Phrase + Thinking Phrase + Business Opinion Phrase

EXAMPLES:

- 1. "That's a good question. + Let me see....", from my point of view,
- 2. "That's a tough question. + Well, ... ", the way I see it,
- 3. "That's an interesting question." + What should I say....," my take is....

<u>Advice</u>: You should try to make these phrases "automatic" when your overseas guest or client asks you a business question.

REMINDER:

- Good Speaking Technique:
- Business Answer phrase → Thinking phrase → Point → Reason → Example → Ending
 Throwback
- Ex. "That's a good question. + Let me see....", From my point of view, mainly because...... A good example is.... That's my opinion. What do you think about....?
